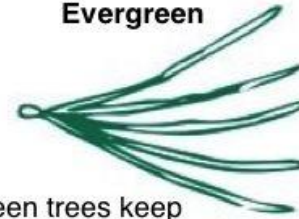


Evergreen vs Deciduous



Evergreen



Evergreen trees keep their leaves (needles) year-round.
Example: Pine

Deciduous



Deciduous trees lose their leaves annually. Example: Oak



Plant Types



Tree

A woody perennial plant, typically having a single stem or trunk growing to a considerable height and bearing lateral branches at some distance from the ground.

Shrub

A woody plant that is smaller than a tree and has several main stems arising at or near the ground.

Grass

Vegetation consisting of typically short plants with long narrow leaves, growing wild or on lawns and in pastures.

Herbaceous plants

Plants that lack woody stems above the surface and dies to the ground at the end of a growing season. Perennial plants.
