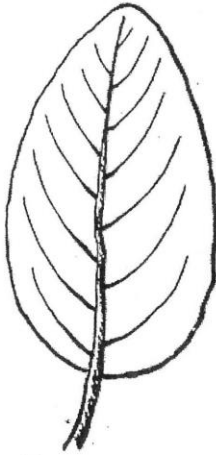


Leaf Shapes



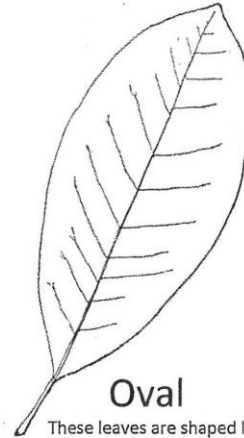
Ovate

These leaves are egg-shaped. They are widest below the middle and narrow at the top.



Oblong

These leaves have parallel sides. They are the same width from top to bottom.



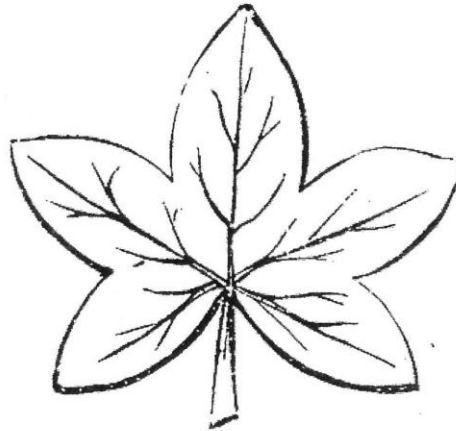
Oval

These leaves are shaped like a football or a flattened circle.



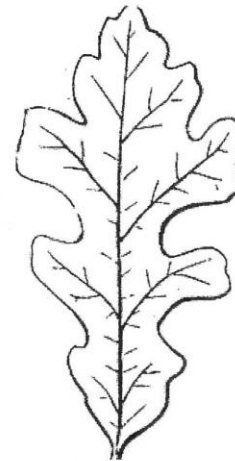
Obovate

These leaves are the opposite of Ovate leaves. They are widest above the middle and narrow at the bottom.



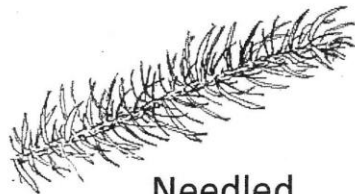
Palmate

These leaves are shaped like an open hand. They have 4 or more sections radiating from a single point.



Lobed

These leaves have many rounded sections like Palmate, but they are not connected at a single point.



Needled

These are hard, narrow, and pointy.
